An Act Permitting Absentee Ballots for Election of Town Officials.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 90-A, §37-A, additional. Chapter 90-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 405 of the public laws of 1957, is amended by adding a new section 37-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 37-A. Absentee ballots. When any town accepts this section and section 37 at a meeting held at least 30 days before the annual meeting, voting for town officials may be by absentee or physical incapacity ballot in accordance with the procedure used in state elections under chapter 6.'
