STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

An Act Relating to Record of Facts Used to Impose Sentence on Persons Convicted.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S.' c. 149, §11, amended. The last sentence of section 11 of chapter 149 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 191 of the public laws of 1959, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'For the purpose of aiding in post conviction review of the sentence imposed, the justice presiding shall record as part of the case the facts that impelled him to impose sentence.'
