HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 69, L. D. 169, Bill, "AN ACT  
Providing a State-Wide Limit on Certain Fish."

Amend said Bill by striking out the last paragraph  
and inserting in place thereof the following:

" 'No person shall take, catch, kill or have in possession  
more than 15 fish of the salmon, trout, togue or black bass  
species in the ~~Counties~~ County of Aroostook, ~~Androscoggin,~~  
~~Cumberland,~~ ~~Hancock,~~ ~~Kennebec,~~ ~~Knox,~~ ~~Lincoln,~~ ~~Oxford,~~ ~~Peneb-~~  
~~scot,~~ ~~Sagadahoc,~~ ~~Walde,~~ ~~Washington~~ ~~and~~ ~~York~~ during any one  
day of any open season, from any or all of the rivers, streams,  
brooks, lakes and ponds in said ~~counties~~ county, except as  
provided for by rules and regulations of the department under  
section 9.' "
