HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to S. P. 69, L. D. 169, Bill, "An Act Providing a State-Wide Limit on Certain Fish."

Amend said Bill by Striking out the last paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:

"'No person shall take, catch, kill or have in possession more than 15 fish of the salmon, trout, togue or black bass species in the Gounties County of Aroostook; -Androseoggin, Gumberland; Hancock; -Kennebee; -Knox; -Lincoln; -Oxford; -Penobseot; -Sagadahoe, Waldo; Washington and York during any one day of any open season, from any or all of the rivers, streams, brooks, lakes and ponds in said counties county, except as provided for by rules and regulations of the department under section 9.'"
