Resolve, to Reimburse the Town of Limestone for 1958 Connor Poll Taxes Paid the State

Town of Limestone; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$324 to be paid to the Town of Limestone as a full and final claim against the State for poll taxes collected by the State from residents of Connor in 1958.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Chapter 16 of the Revised Statutes, section 104, provides that in the year in which a biennial state election is held, Limestone receives the poll taxes paid by the residents of Connor to the State. Such payment is to reimburse the Town of Limestone for expenses of the election in Connor. Payment is made on application for the money. The Town of Limestone was late in applying and this resolve is to reimburse said town.
