STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Associate Judges or Recorders Pro Tempore of Municipal Courts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 108, § 3, amended. Section 3 of chapter 108 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding at the end, a new paragraph, as follows:

'In the event of the death or resignation or any vacancy in the position of recorder or associate judge of any municipal court, the judge of said court may appoint some person to be recorder pro tempore or associate judge pro tempore and said person shall hold office until a recorder or associate judge is appointed and qualified under the Constitution and laws of this State.'
