HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 148, L.D. 211, Resolve, Regulating
Taking of Smelts in Kingsbury Pond and Mayfield Pond.

Amend said Resolve by inserting after the title the
following emergency preamble:

'Emergency Preamble. Whereas, acts and resolves do not
become effective until 90 days after the adjournment of the
Legislature unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, fishing is one of Maine's greatest natural
resources and should be encouraged and promoted as much as
possible; and

Whereas, it is vitally necessary that the following
legislation be passed in order to aid in the conservation of
this natural resource; and

Whereas, such conservation should be instituted in the
spring of 1961; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution
of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health
and safety; now, therefore, be it'

Further amend said Resolve by adding at the end the
following emergency clause:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in
the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.'
