SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 151, L. D. 214, Bill, "An Act Relating to Compensation for Certain Policemen under Occupational Disease Law."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of those parts designated "16." and inserting in place thereof the following:

  within 6 months of such
