STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Compensation of Certain Policemen under Occupational Disease Law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 31, § 69, amended. That part of section 69 of chapter 31 of the Revised Statutes numbered 16, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 391 of the public laws of 1955 and as amended by section 1 of chapter 265 of the public laws of 1959, is further amended to read as follows:

'16. Pulmonary and cardiac diseases, excluding common colds.
16. Caused to an active member of an organized fire or police department while participating at fires or while engaged in active police duty, and developing within 6 months of such participation.'

Sec. 2. Effective date. This act shall take effect on November 30, 1961.
