STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Office Hours of Office of Mayor of Lewiston.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. IV, § 4, additional. Article IV of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939, as amended, is further amended by adding a new section 4, to read as follows:

'Sec. 4. Office hours. The office of the mayor shall be kept open for the transaction of the business of the City of Lewiston during all normal working hours of the city hall. The mayor may appoint a secretary, prescribe her duties, set her compensation subject to the approval of the board of finance, and terminate her employment at pleasure.'
