An ACT Relating to Compensation of Medical Examiners for View Without Autopsy.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 89, §252, amended. The first sentence of section 252 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 339 of the public laws of 1957, is further amended to read as follows:

‘Every medical examiner shall render an account of the expenses of each case, including his fees, to the county attorney, who shall audit and approve the same before it is submitted to the county commissioners for their approval, and the fees allowed the medical examiner shall not exceed the following: For a view and inquiry without an autopsy ~~\$15~~ **\$25**; for a view and autopsy, \$50; when the medical examiner performing an autopsy is a pathologist, \$100, whether he makes a view or not; for an inquest, \$10 per day for the time actually spent in holding such inquest and for all necessary travel at the rate of 10c per mile.’
