## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

#### AN ACT Relating to Certain Per Diem Fees of Deputy Sheriffs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., c. 89, § 150, sub-§ XIV, amended. Subsection XIV of section 150 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 1 of chapter 328 of the public laws of 1959, is further amended to read as follows:
  - 'XIV. Attending court and keeping prisoner. For attending court and keeping the prisoner in criminal cases, \$11 \$13 a day, and in that proportion for a greater or shorter length of time.'
- Sec. 2. R. S., c. 89, § 150, sub-§ XV, amended. The last sentence of subsection XV of section 150 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 267 of the public laws of 1955 and as amended by section 3 of chapter 328 of the public laws of 1959, is further amended to read as follows:

'The superior court messenger of Cumberland County shall also receive \$11 \$13 per day for court vacation time, service and attendance when said service and attendance are authorized by a Justice of the Superior Court.'

Sec. 3. R. S., c. 89, § 150, sub-§ XVI, amended. The first sentence of sub-section XVI of section 150 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 2 of chapter 328 of the public laws of 1959, is further amended to read as follows:

'Every deputy sheriff while performing special duties under order of the sheriff shall receive for such services \$13 a day, together with necessary, incidental expenses, to be paid from the county treasury, the bills for which shall be audited as provided in chapter 150, section 2.'
