HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 167, L. D. 230, Bill, "An Act Relating

to Special Deputies for Kennebec and Penobscot Counties."

Amend said Bill in the title by striking out everything after the words "Deputies for" and inserting in place thereof the words and punctuation 'All Counties.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of that part designated "Sec. 173." and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 173. Special deputies in all counties; compensation. The sheriff sheriffs of Cumberland-County all counties shall respectively appoint full-time deputy sheriffs, who shall serve at the pleasure of said sheriff respective sheriffs and whose special duty shall be to enforce the criminal laws in said county counties and who shall receive as compensation therefor the sum of \$\\$11 per day and such additional pay as the respective county commissioners may approve, to be paid from the respective county treasury treasuries, together with such incidental expenses as may be necessary for the proper enforcement of said laws; bills for which shall be audited as provided in chapter 150, section 2. Such full-time deputy sheriffs shall not receive more than \$77 in the aggregate for any one week, except that this limitation shall not apply to Cumberland County.
