SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 167, L. D. 230, Bill, "An Act Relating to Special Deputies for Kennebec and Penobscot Counties."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the title and inserting in place thereof the following: 'An Act Relating to Appointment and Compensation of Deputy Sheriffs.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line the abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all of the 4th, 5th and 6th lines and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 173. Deputy sheriffs; compensation. The sheriff of ~~Gumberland-County-shall~~ each county may respectively appoint'

Further amend said Bill by adding at the end thereof the following section:

'Sec. 2. Effective date. This act shall take effect January 1, 1962.'
