**AN ACT Relating to Compensation of Chief Deputy Sheriffs Performing
Special Duties.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 89, §150, sub-§XVI, amended. Subsection XVI of section 150 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 2 of chapter 328 of the public laws of 1959, is further amended by adding at the end, a new sentence, as follows:

'A chief deputy performing similar special duties shall receive an additional \$2 per day.'
