# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

#### AN ACT Relating to Uniforms for Deputy Sheriffs.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 89, § 151, amended. The last 2 sentences of section 151 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 271 of the public laws of 1959, are further amended to read as follows:

'He shall require any of said deputies while engaged in the enforcement of the provisions of section 153 of chapter 22 to wear a uniform sufficient to identify themselves as officers of the law. Upon approval of the county commissioners, uniforms required by this section but not exceeding 4 for any one county shall be furnished by the county.'
