**RESOLVE, Appropriating Moneys to Provide Promotion for Maine's
Industrial Development.**

Department of Economic Development; appropriation. Resolved: That there is appropriated the sum of \$1,000,000 from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to the Department of Economic Development for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1962 to provide additional promotion for Maine's industrial development. Said appropriation shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until June 30, 1963.

STATEMENT OF FACTS
