AN ACT Relating to Open Season for Trout in York County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S. c. 37, §44, sub-§I, amended. Subsection I of section 44 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended to read as follows:

'I. All fish except black bass in lakes and ponds, and trout in brooks and streams of York County. For all fish except black bass in lakes and ponds, there shall be an open season in waters naturally free of ice or any portions of waters naturally free of ice from April 1st until September 30th, **except the open season for trout in brooks and streams of York County shall be from May 1st to to September 30th.'**
