STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Name on Arrows of Those Hunting With Bow and Arrow.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, §110, amended. Section 110 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended by adding at the end, a new paragraph, as follows:

'Each person holding a license to hunt with bow and arrow shall affix to the shaft of each arrow in his possession while in the pursuit of game his name in legible characters.'
