RESOLVE, Regulating Ice Fishing in Spring Lake, T3 R4, Somerset County.

Ice Fishing in Spring Lake, regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Spring Lake, T3 R4, Somerset County, to ice fishing from February 1st to March 31st each year and also prohibiting the use or possession of live fish as bait.
