STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Bulldozing into Great Ponds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 22, amended. Section 22 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph, as follows:

It shall be unlawful for the owner or owners of any property, bordering Great Ponds to bulldoze or otherwise deposit earth fill into a great pond, beyond the high water line of the great pond, without having made application in writing to the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game and unless said department grants permission. Whoever violates this paragraph shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$100 nor more than \$500.'
