STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Increasing Compensation of Members of Maine State Park Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 36, § 34, amended. The last sentence of the first paragraph of section 34 of chapter 36 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'Each member shall be paid the sum of \$10 per diem for the time actually spent by each in transacting official business of the commission, payment to be made as hereinafter provided for.'
