AN ACT Relating to Open Season for Fishing During Month of October.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 44, sub-§ VI, additional. Section 44 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended by adding a new subsection VI, to read as follows:

'VI. Fishing in October. In accordance with section 9, the commissioner may open waters of this State to the taking of any species of fish except trout, salmon or togue during the month of October.'
