STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Bank Checks with Bids on Highway Construction.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 23, § 40, amended. The 3rd and 5th sentences of section 40 of chapter 23 of the Revised Statutes are amended to read as follows:

'Each bidder must accompany his bid with an official bank check, a cashier's check, a certified check or a United States postal money order, payable to the Treasurer of State, for an amount which the commission considers sufficient to guarantee that if the work is awarded to him he will contract with the commission for its due execution; such. Such checks or money orders shall be returned to the respective unsuccessful bidders.'

'All bids so submitted shall be publicly opened and read and posted at the time and place stated in such advertisement.'
