# IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

## AN ACT Prohibiting Race or Color Disclosure in Vital Records.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- **R. S., c. 25, § 397-A, sub-§ I, amended.** Subsection I of section 397-A of chapter 25 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 7 of chapter 298 of the public laws of 1957, is amended to read as follows:
  - **I.** Illegitimacy. No official in this State shall permit inspection, or issue a certified copy of any eertificate or record of birth, marriage or death disclosing race or color, or, in case of birth, disclosing illegitimacy. Such a record Records of illegitimacy may be disclosed or a certified copy issued upon request of the illegitimate himself, or his legal guardian or counsel or of petitioners for adoption or in response to court process.'
