STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Political Registration of Members of City of Lewiston Boards and Commissions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. XVI, § 2, repealed. Section 2 of Article XVI of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939, as amended by section 28 of chapter 86 of the private and special laws of 1943, is repealed as follows:

'See. 2. Registration of members in political parties. Not more than 3 members of the board of finance or of any departmental board of 5 shall be registered in the same political party at the time of appointment and not more than 2 members of any such commission of 3 shall be so registered, provided, however, that a majority of every said board to be appointed by the mayor shall be chosen from those enrolled as members of that party in said eity of Lewiston which polled the plurality of votes in said eity, for governor, in the last gubernatorial election preceding the date of appointment. To be eligible for appointment, a member shall be registered in the party he represents at least 6 months prior to the date of appointment, and provided also that he shall not have been registered in any other party within ± year prior to the time of appointment.'
