STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Increasing Salaries of County Officials of Franklin County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 89, § 254, amended. The 5th paragraph of section 254 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 7 of chapter 372 of the public laws of 1959, which relates to Franklin County, is amended to read as follows:

'Franklin County: County commissioners, \$700 \$900; clerk of courts, \$2,400 \$3,400; county attorney, \$2,000 \$3,000; county treasurer, \$1,100 \$1,200; sheriff, \$2,700 \$3,700; register of deeds, \$2,300 \$3,300; judge of probate, \$1,600 \$2,000; register of probate, \$2,200 \$3,200; Franklin municipal court judge, \$3,000.'

Sec. 2. Effective date. This act shall be retroactive to January 1, 1961.
