AN ACT Providing State Aid to Municipalities That Purchase Voting Machines.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. State funds for voting machines. Any municipality which has purchased or does purchase voting machines under the Revised Statutes, chapter 5-A, shall be reimbursed by the State for 20% of the total cost of such machines upon proof of the facts in form satisfactory to the Secretary of State.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to the office of the Secretary of State the sum of \$50,000 to carry out the purposes of this act. Any unexpended balances shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account.
