STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Eliminating Registration and License for Certain Farm Trailers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 13, amended. The 9th paragraph of section 13 of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'No registration or license shall be required for a farm tractor or a farm trailer when the same is used solely for farming purposes, and such farm tractors and farm trailers may be operated, without registration or license, from or to the premises where the same are kept, to or from a farm lot and between farm lots, used for farm purposes by the owner of the farm tractor or farm trailer; and such. Such farm tractors and farm trailers may be operated, without registration or license, from or to a filling station or garage for gas, oil or repairs.'
