**AN ACT to Construct Wing on Stevens Hall, North at the University of Maine
in Orono.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Wing on Stevens Hall, North; construction of. The University of Maine is authorized to construct, furnish and equip a wing on Stevens Hall, North at its Orono campus.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated to the University of Maine the sum of \$635,000 from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to carry out this act. Such appropriation shall not lapse, but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this act have been accomplished.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Stevens Hall, North is used primarily for the Departments of Foreign Languages and Psychology.

Both departments have inadequate space and facilities for existing student enrollment.

The demand for courses in these 2 fields increases each year without making allowance for increased enrollment.

Enrollment in these fields must be restricted essentially to present levels unless additional space and facilities are provided.
