#### RESOLVE, Appropriating Funds for Advisory Committee on Education.

Advisory Committee on Education; appropriation. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$4,258 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1962 and \$4,258 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1963 for secretarial and other expenses of the Advisory Committee on Education. Such appropriation shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until June 30, 1963. The breakdown shall be as follows:

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

An Advisory Committee on Education was created by Resolves, 1957, chapter 160, and the private and special laws of 1959, chapter 161, provided \$2,000 for expenses of the committee. The Governor and Council, through contingent account transfers, have provided \$3,000 to provide funds for a part-time executive secretary, office space and traveling expense. This resolve is for the purpose of continuing the services of a secretary and traveling expense.
