STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Prohibiting Hunting Near Occupied Dwellings.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 77-A, additional. Chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended by adding a new section 77-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 77-A. Hunting near dwellings prohibited. It shall be unlawful for any person to hunt any wild bird or wild animal at any time nearer than 500 feet from the occupied dwelling of another, except when authorized by the occupant.'
