IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Moose River, Somerset County.

Fishing in Moose River, regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game is authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation closing Moose River, Somerset County, from the red post 150' below Brassua Dam to the mouth of Moose River, in Rockwood Strip and Taunton Raynham Grant, T1 R1, from October 1st to April 30th of the following year. Said river shall be open under the general law from May 1st to September 15th, and open to fly fishing only, with a daily bag limit of 2 trout, salmon or togue from September 16th to September 30th.
