RESOLVE, Opening Aroostook River to Ice Fishing.

Ice Fishing in Aroostook River, regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening the Aroostook River, Aroostook County, below the Ashland bridge in Ashland to ice fishing during February and March of each year.
