**RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Little Jim Pond, Franklin County.**

---

**Fishing in Little Jim Pond; regulated. Resolved:** That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game is authorized and directed to open Little Jim Pond in T. 1, R. 5 and T. 4, R. 5, Franklin County, to fishing under the general law and establishing a daily limit of 5 trout or salmon and prohibiting the use or possession of live fish as bait.
