STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to First Baptist Church of Kittery Point.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The First Baptist Society in the Town of Kittery; name changed. The name of "The First Baptist Society in the Town of Kittery" is changed to "First Baptist Church of Kittery Point" and all the proceedings of said corporation are ratified and made legal.

Said First Baptist Church of Kittery Point is authorized and empowered to hold real estate and its title is confirmed to all of the real estate heretofore held by said corporation under its several names including any real estate which may be hereafter devised to it.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

"The First Baptist Society in the Town of Kittery" was incorporated by an act of the Massachusetts General Court in 1811, and said corporation has had continuous existence since that time.

Said corporation was later known as "The Free Will Baptist Society of Kittery Point in the State of Maine", and also as "The Free Will Baptist Society of Kittery".

Said corporation is now known as the "First Baptist Church of Kittery Point".

Said corporation has acquired real estate under the names of "Kittery First Free Will Society", "Free Will Baptist Society, Kittery", "Kittery Second Baptist Society", "Free Will Baptist Society of Kittery Point" and "Kittery Free Will Baptist Church and Society, Kittery Point."
