#### **AN ACT Relating to Employment of Minors Under 18 Years of Age.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 30, § 22, amended.** Section 22 of chapter 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'**Sec. 22. Employment of minors under 18.** No minor under 18 years of age shall be employed ~~in, about or in connection with any manufacturing or mechanical establishment, laundry, dry cleaning establishment or bakery~~ in any capacity that the commissioner determines to be hazardous, dangerous to their lives or limbs, injurious to morals or where their health will be injured. ~~The provisions of this~~ This section shall not apply to minors in public and approved private schools wherein mechanical equipment is installed and operated primarily for purposes of instruction.'
