

## STATE OF MAINE SENATE 100th LEGISLATURE

SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 255, L. D. 369, Bill, "An Act Relating to Costs of Witness and Attorney Fees Under Workmen's Compensation Act."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the underlined paragraph at the end and inserting in place thereof the following underlined paragraph:

" 'In proceedings under sections 1 to 47, no agent or attorney shall represent the employer, the employee or the insurance company, either in hearings before the Industrial Accident Commission or in negotiations between and among the employee, the employer and the insurance company prior to hearing. A corporation may, in the discretion of the Industrial Accident Commission, appoint an officer of the corporation, not an attorney at law, to represent the corporation in industrial accident proceedings.'"
