COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 261, L.D. 375, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Police Power Ordinances for Ogunquit Village
Corporation."

Amend said Bill by inserting before the enacting clause
the following emergency preamble:

'EMERGENCY PREAMBLE. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do
not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless
enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas further delay in authorizing and empowering the
Ogunquit Village Corporation to enact certain police power
ordinances would render hardship upon the citizens thereof; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts
create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of
Maine and require the following legislation as immediately
necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and
safety.'

And further amend said Bill by adding the following
emergency clause:

'EMERGENCY CLAUSE. In view of the emergency cited in the
preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'
