STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Lobster and Crab Fishing License Fees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- R. S., c. 37-A, § 66, sub-§ V, repealed and replaced. Subsection V of section 66 of chapter 37-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section I of chapter 331 of the public laws of 1959, is repealed and the following enacted:
 - 'V. License fee. The fee for a lobster and crab fishing license shall be in accordance with the following schedule and shall be enclosed by the applicant with his application:

1st license issued to applicant	\$50
2nd license issued to applicant	\$35
3rd license issued to applicant	\$20
4th, and each succeeding license issued to applicant to age 60	\$10
License issued to applicants over age 60	ο'
