**AN ACT to Exempt University of Maine from Laws Relating to Bureau of
Public Improvements.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 15-A, § 24, amended. Section 24 of chapter 15-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 340 of the public laws of 1957, is amended by adding a new sentence to read as follows:

'Nothing in this section shall apply to the construction, improvement or repair of any and all grounds, buildings, facilities and public services which are under the supervision of the trustees of the University of Maine.'
