IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Salaries of Certain Officers of Cumberland County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 89, § 254, amended. Those parts of the 4th paragraph of section 254 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 7 of chapter 372 of the public laws of 1959, which relate to the salaries of register of deeds, deputy register of deeds and register of probate of Cumberland County, are amended to read as follows:

'register of deeds ~~\$5,000~~ \$6,500; deputy register of deeds, ~~\$4,000~~ \$4,500; register of probate, ~~\$4,700~~ \$7,000;'
