AN ACT Relating to Fees of Deputy Sheriffs for Court Attendance.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 89, § 150, sub-§ XV, amended. Subsection XV of section 150 of chapter 89 of the Revised Statutes, as last amended by section 3 of chapter 328 of the public laws of 1959, is further amended to read as follows:

'XV. Special duties. Every deputy sheriff and court messenger, while in attendance upon the Supreme Judicial Court or the Superior Court in their several counties except as provided in ~~section 14~~ of chapter 103, **section 14**, shall receive for said attendance and service ~~\$10~~ **\$11** a day while the court is in session to run continuously from the commencement of such attendance and service until adjournment unless sooner released by the court, plus their actual travel at 20c a mile from their place of abode for each day's attendance. The superior court messenger of Cumberland County shall also receive **\$11** per day for court vacation time, service and attendance when said service and attendance are authorized by a Justice of the Superior Court.'
