#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

## AN ACT Relating to Allowance for Uniforms of the Police Department of the City of Lewiston.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. XI, § 7-A, amended.** Section 7-A of article XI of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939, as enacted by chapter 191 of the private and special laws of 1951 and as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 7-A. Uniforms for members. The city shall supply male members of the police department with necessary uniforms, but shall not expend more than 5100 \$150 per member annually. The city shall supply male members of the police department who do not wear uniforms a clothing allowance not to exceed \$100 \$150 annually. The provisions of this This section shall apply only to those who have been appointed permanent members of the police department for at least one year.'
