IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Providing for Construction of Campus Roads and Parking Areas,
Phase 1, at the University of Maine in Orono.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Campus roads and parking areas, phase 1, construction of. The University of Maine is authorized to construct certain campus roads and parking areas to provide the first step in the orderly development of the campus to meet enrollment demands.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated to the University of Maine the sum of \$150,000 from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to carry out this act. Such appropriation shall not lapse, but shall remain a continuing carrying account until the purposes of this act have been accomplished.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This is the first step in the development of roads and parking areas in order to keep the commuter traffic away from the interior of the campus where pedestrian traffic is very heavy. This construction is in accordance with a master plan of development of the university to provide for doubling the student enrollment by 1970.

This road is also designed to service the University Press and the Service Building in their new locations at the outer edge of the campus.
