COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 165, L. D. 411, Bill, "An Act
Relating to Retirement of Chief Warden of Inland
Fisheries and Game."

Amend said Bill in the title by striking out the words
"of Chief Warden" and by inserting before the period at the end
of title the word 'Wardens'

Further amend said Bill by striking out the last 4 lines
and inserting in place thereof the following:

"such request, of the service of such member, and except that the
Chief Warden, the assistant chief warden and the warden super-
visors in the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game may remain
in service until they have attained the age of 65."
