RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Dodge Pond, Franklin County.

Fishing in Dodge Pond, regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game is authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation to open Dodge Pond, in the Town of Rangeley, County of Franklin, to fishing under the general law.
