RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Long Pond, Franklin County.

Fishing in Long Pond regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation prohibiting plugfishing in Long Pond, Sandy River Plantation, Franklin County, except from stationary wharves.
