SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Appointment of Examiners of Insane Convicts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 27, § 122, amended. The first sentence of section 122 of chapter 27 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'The Governor shall appoint in each county in the State ~~a~~ **one or more** competent ~~physician~~ **physicians**, who shall be ~~a resident~~ **residents** of the county, to act as an examiner of insane convicts in the county jail of the county.'
