STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SIXTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Appointment of Examiners of Insane Convicts.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 27, § 122, amended. The first sentence of section 122 of chapter 27 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'The Governor shall appoint in each couny in the State a one or more competent physicians, who shall be a resident residents of the county, to act as an examiner of insane convicts in the county jail of the county.'
